PĀV's first project was the installation of four sculptures on Main Street. Our goal is to introduce new pieces annually, identify future locations, and build a permanent collection.

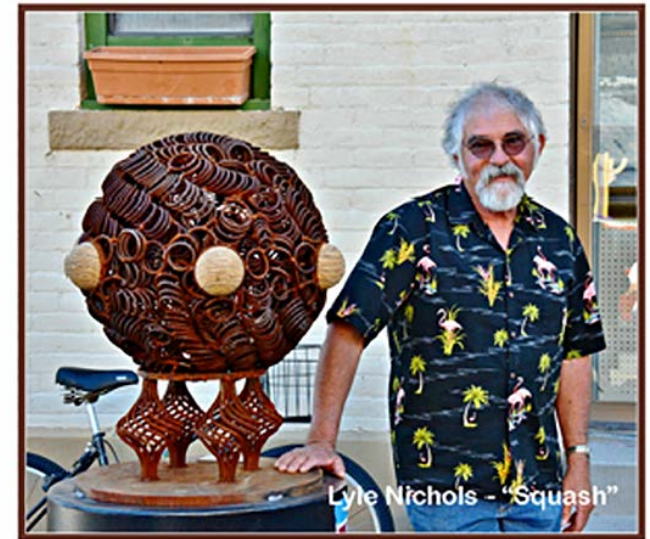
Artists loan their work free of charge for one year. In return, the sculptors are provided an installation stipend, and marketing. Pieces are available for purchase, or as a legacy program to honor a loved one.

25% of the purchase price is retained to fund this public arts program. seeks sustainable funding through the generous donations of individuals and organizations.



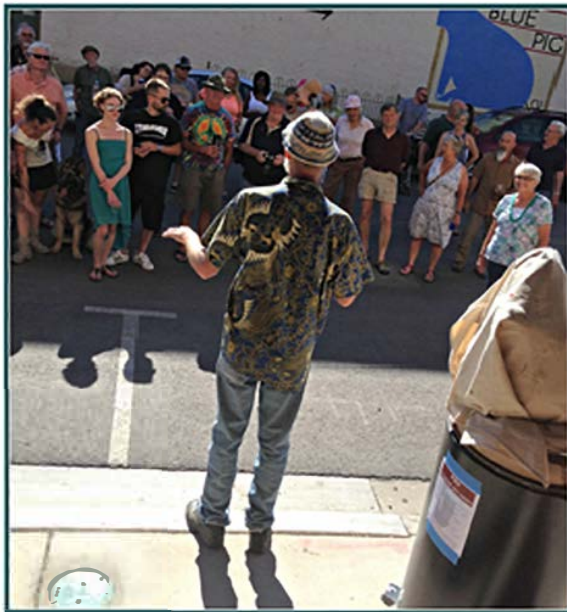
Dave Davis - "Falling Dime".

Dave Davis founded Grand Junction's outdoor public sculpture program in 1984, which has been duplicated in cities around the world and has earned him the Colorado Governor's Award

"Spring Herons", by sculptor Steve Kentz, was carved from a 400 lb. block of Vermont Marble that was originally intended to become a headstone. Appropriately, this piece was purchased by the family and friends of Betty Hauschulz as a memorial. "Spring Herons" is now PĀV's first of a permanent sculpture collection.
